

Laser Vision Correction Payment Plan Terms and Conditions

Dr Ben LaHood is a consulting ophthalmologist and eye surgeon at Adelaide Eye & Laser Centre, which has a priority affiliation with ParkView Day Surgery. His laser vision correction patients that participate in the Laser Vision Payment Plan will be managed surgically at ParkView Day Surgery (PVDS).

- 1. Agreements between PVDS and the applicant are activated once the planned procedure has been performed.
- 2. Monthly payments are via direct debit from the patients nominated account.
- 3. The first monthly payment is due one (1) calendar month from the date of surgery.
- 4. Payments are taken on a monthly basis.
- 5. Reminders regarding upcoming payments will be provided to the nominated email within five (5) days before the due date.
- 6. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that sufficient funds are available in the nominated account on the due date.
- 7. Each reminder notice will provide an early pay out figure at a discount to the remaining balance.
- 8. Early pay outs are processed by a single direct debit from the nominated account.
- 9. Early payouts must be completed before the due date of the next payment.
- 10. Part payment of monthly instalments or pay out figures are not possible.
- 11. PVDS reserves the right to decline access to the payment plan at its complete discretion.
- 12. The PVDS payment plan cannot be used with any other offer.
- 13. A dishonour fee may be levied by PVDS at its discretion.
- 14. Direct debit arrangements are between the applicant and Westpac. PVDS does not retain the applicants account details.
